

For the Academic year 2024-25, we are receiving applications requesting for support to pursue B tech, MBBS, Intermediate with JEE, NEET or CA Foundation & Other professional courses.

During the current academic year ie; 2024-25 an amount of Rs.12.02 lakhs was disbursed to 20 students including fresh disbursements and renewal support.

Cumulatively, under Higher Education segment, till date we have provided financial support of Rs.483.19 lakhs to 367 meritorious and deserving students from various disciplines including Engineering / Medicine / CA / Civil Services, Inter (with Foundation Course) / Integrated LLB / CMA towards college fee, hostel/mess fee. For these students we have committed an amount of Rs.278.54 lakhs for the remaining period of education which will be disbursed in the next 1 to 3 years (includes the cost of 27 civil services students already sponsored).

Most of our beneficiaries are from rural or semi-urban backgrounds.
